His 2004 Sancerre Les Monts Damnes smells decidedly of crushed stone and chalk, with suggestions of gooseberry, citrus and herb. On the palate, the wine is adamantly chalky and implacably dense, with a Chablis-like chicken broth mineral richness accented by faintly bitter herb and lemon pip notes. The finish is unusually austere for a Cotat Sancerre, but, like liquid stone, impressively saturates the palate with the essence of those "damned mountains" mother chalk.
